With our Play in a Box program, students ages 8 through 12 will learn the basics of acting, character development, and storytelling while having fun, learning teamwork skills

and rehearsing a production. Up to 20 students meet 1.5 hours once a week in your multipurpose room, and after 10 weeks present a finished play to parents and students.



Each session can accommodate up to twenty students. Your school also has the opportunity to sell tickets and concessions as a fundraiser.

PYT provides the backdrops, costume plot, music CD and script. Our instructors are experienced theater professionals who have worked and taught throughout the Bay Area.
